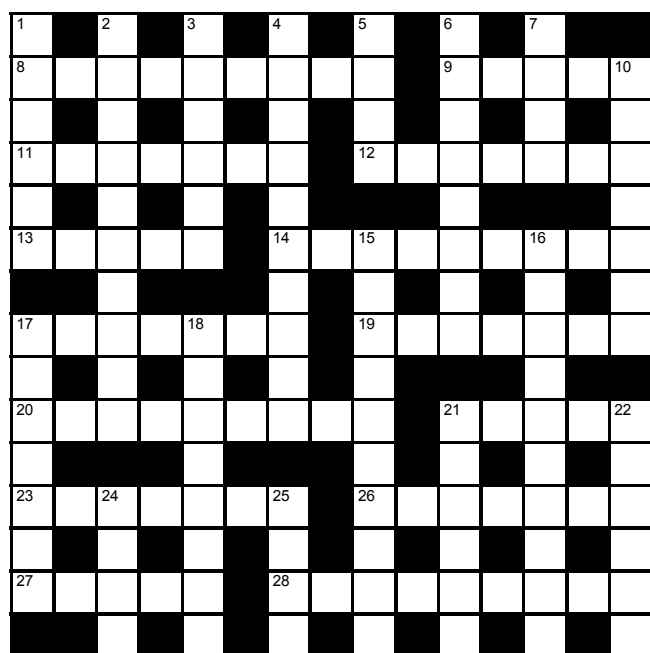


## Unexpected Bonus
